Class Description

Directed Studies is a resource class which focuses on assisting students to progress on their IEP goals. A portion of each class period will be spent in using their planner, recording homework, self-evaluation, and strategies to increase their ability to succeed in school (as needed). Students will be taught study skills that can then be applied to school assignments along with specialized instruction for students' IEP goals will be included during this course.

Objective

Each student is expected to make progress on his/her individualized IEP goals and monitor his/her performance in all classes.

Materials

The following materials are required in class each day:

- Three ring binder, binder dividers - Provided and remains in the classroom
- Binder paper
- Student planner
- Pen and pencil
- Any other necessary books and materials
- Homework from other classes and a reading book for when assignments are completed

Progress Monitoring/Grading Policy

Progress on IEP goals will be monitored and documented on a weekly basis with teacher and student input. Students will grade their attendance, class participation, appropriate behavior, self-evaluation, and progress made toward IEP goals daily (see attached). Teachers will review student self-evaluation, use observation, and the SIS system to evaluate progress toward IEP goals. Students and parents will receive a summary of progress at the end of each term at approximately the same time report cards are disbursed. Students and parents may also track grades and attendance on the SIS system.

Attendance
