FlexGE students take GE courses through BYU and then apply to BYU or another college or university to complete the bachelor degree of their choice.



For **US citizens**, starting the FlexGE program may include moving to Utah for a fresh start, Utah residency, a better dating scene, or easy access to fry sauce. Utah-based students may opt to move to the Provo-Orem area to live with friends and soak up the BYU atmosphere. Online courses make it possible for FlexGE students to live at home, worldwide.

International students who plan to earn a US degree can take BYU Independent Study courses online from their home country. They just need to check with any desired US school(s) to make sure course credits will transfer properly.

Transferring to Another School

FlexGE students are usually new to higher education and enroll in 9 to 12 general education credits (3 or 4 courses) at a time. With FlexGE credits, students can (re)apply to BYU or another university as a transfer applicant, which means they do **not** submit high school records. Here's how it works:

- Students ask their intended school(s) about (1) how many credits and (2) which course credits are needed for Transfer Student status.
- They earn **graded** GE credits (excluding AP credits and P grades).
- Only college-level transcripts are required for transfer applications (no high school data).
- Find links about transferring to BYU at enrollment.byu.edu/admissions.



FlexGE Enrollment Instructions

To register for on-campus courses (Evening, SLC, Spring/Summer):

1. Create a [Net ID](#) if you don't have one.
2. Complete the [Clearance to Register](#) application and [Ecclesiastical Endorsement](#).
3. Review the [Class Schedule](#) and the [University Catalog](#) to explore requirements and courses.
4. Log in to my.byu.edu.
5. Click on MyMAP to access the registration system and search for your desired courses.
6. Add class sections. If your registration window is not yet open, add courses to your cart and check out (6+ hours before deadline).

To register for BYU Independent Study online courses:

1. Select a course from the [course catalog](#) on is.byu.edu.
2. Confirm with an admissions counselor at your intended school(s) that the course credits align with their requirements and will transfer.
3. Register for the course online, over the phone, or in person.
4. Access your course through our website using your BYU Net ID (username) and password (or create an account first if needed).

Support for FlexGE Students

We encourage students to apply for scholarships on the [FlexGE @BYU](#) website's [scholarship application](#) as FlexGE courses do not qualify for Federal Financial Aid. [Short-Term Loans](#) are another option for on-campus courses.

FlexGE advisors are eager to help students identify courses that will transfer and cover GE requirements at other universities. Students can schedule an appointment with an advisor to help with planning:

- Registration
- Course selection
- Course issues
- GE requirements
- Transfer plan
- Transfer credits
- Major/career exploration
- Withdrawal or discontinuance
